Course Title: PHTSHOP1: Adobe Photoshop Level 1

Course Length: 1 day

Instructional Methodology: Instructor-led, with computer lab hands-on activities

Prerequisites: Little or no experience using Adobe Photoshop is necessary for this class, which is designed to teach students the basic skills necessary to begin using this program effectively.

Course Description: In this course, students learn to use several Adobe Photoshop tools for selecting parts of images, and moving, duplicating, and resizing images. You will learn how to use layers, and to apply layer effects and filters to create special effects, including lighting and texture. Students will also learn how to use painting tools and blending modes to create shading effects, and perform adjustments to contrast and color balance. You will save images in formats for print and Web use.
