Site Telephone Number:

There is a cell phone number for your AYU camp from June 1-5, Monday through Friday from 7:30am until 5pm. Camp Location:

UA University Services Annex Building, 220 W. 6th Street, Bldg. B, Room B116B, These rooms are used by the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute at The University of Arizona (OLLI).

Directions: Sixth Street & Main Street; USA gated complex; blue UA sign facing 6th reads ‘**University Services Annex**’, but no physical address shown. OLLI occupies the ground floor in the 2-story building (5-story & 2-story buildings within fenced complex); southeast corner on ground floor. Two separate entrances once facing east and one facing south; sign on door reads ‘**Osher Lifelong Learning Institute at The University of Arizona**’.
