## CSI SCIENCE CAMP!

July 7-11 8:30am-4:30pm

### **Site Telephone Number:**

There is a cell phone number for your AYU camp from July 7-11, Monday through Friday from 7:30am until 5pm. **The cell phone number will be posted on the AYU website on or after May 29:** [www.ceao.arizona.edu/child](http://www.ceao.arizona.edu/child) or you may call the registration number at 621-7724.

**Checking in and out will be done at the front entrance of the Arizona Cancer Center. A CEAO staff member will be there at 8:05 am for check-in and 4:20 for check out. Checking out will be done at the main entrance where you dropped off your child in the morning.**

**Please drop your child campers off by 8:15am so that camp may begin promptly at 8:30am.**

### **Dress Code:**

Lab coat will be provided and must be worn during the camp.

Long pants or jeans are OK. No shorts.

Closed toed shoes or tennis shoes are acceptable. No open toed shoes or sandals

Please have your child wear sunscreen and bring a hat as there are some outdoor activities scheduled.

Please drop off your child under the Arizona Cancer Center Portico. There are a few 20 minute parking spaces available.

Paid Parking is available at the University Medical Center Visitor Parking Garage which is located adjacent to the Arizona Cancer Center.

### **Lunch:**

Students need to bring a sack lunch, snacks, and drink/water. There are no refrigerated facilities for lunches. There will be a lunch break and it will be with the instructors.

Cafeteria facilities or vending machines will NOT be available.

### **Emergency Form:**

The emergency contact and information form must be received by Continuing Education and Academic Outreach (CEAO) **PRIOR** to your child attending the camp. This form requests emergency contact information. If you have misplaced this form, please call the Registration Line at 621-7724 and another form can be **faxed or emailed** to you.

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**Student Pick-up:**

The camp will end at 4:20pm each day. Please meet the CEAO staff member inside the lobby of the Arizona Cancer Center (where you dropped him/her off in the morning) between 4:20 and 4:30 pm for checking your student out for the day.

You must check your camper out with the staff person.

**Please remember to be prompt!**

**If your child needs to wait for a parent, a note must be received from the parent stating that their child has permission to wait on his/her own, the name of the camp, and dates of the camp with your signature and phone number.**
